If your train looks to be lagging, the cause is in all likelihood because there is some dirt, rust, or oil build up on either the track or the wheels of the train. These build ups can affect the connection between the track and the train. Say there is not a good connector, then it doesn't function as well.

Cleaning Dusts From The Track and Wheels

If you see some rust, apply whatsoever sand paper to remove it. Say there is serious build up, you can use a substitute knife to scrape off the widest part of it. Alternatively, you can use rust remover. After you remove the rust, saturate a soft cloth with light oil sprayer, and rub the track with it. Then buff it with a clean part of the fabric.

Say you see whatsoever greenish or crusty white build up, this is oxidation. Just soak your track in oxidation remover for a few minutes, and then carry through with the fresh oil spray and buffing.

Be certain you do not ever practice steel wool on your tracks. Small molecules of the steel wool will come off and then stay to the track. These particles will get picked up by your railway locomotive, and could cause plenty harm to ruin it.

Say you have whatsoever stubborn stains of stain, a hard eraser will get rid of them.

Take After the comparable procedure for the wheels, but a Q-Tip soaked with the oil spray operates fresher for cleaning the soil from them.

Repairing The Track Regions So They Fit Unitedly Snugly

Some Other 1 of your general Lionel train amends is acquiring the divisions of your track to fit tightly together. Over time, the connections tend to become slightly bent, loosening up the connections. When you encounter this problem, use needle nose pliers to cautiously bend the connectors back into place. When you have them back where they should be, your track areas will fit snugly together again.

Repairing The Cars

Preserving your cars in tip top process is as well primary. Grease and oil can build in these too. Utilize the light oil sprayer to clean them. Say you need to utilize some oil to small moving parts, use a toothpick to transfer a average drop of oil to where you need it. You do not want to overdo it in utilising the oil.

Most of the time you can replace any parts that need replacing yourself. Usually they are connected with average screws. Plainly unscrew the region and screw the new section into place.
