Club membership is reasonably priced, costing £14 for individuals and £16 for families, entitling you to a copy of Start Line every month and discounted entry fees to events. Do two or more of the events and eventually you will save more than your membership fee. Membership runs from January 1st out, and if you join at the Classic Show in August you get the whole of the following year free. Combining Wigdon with a self-catering holiday makes eminent sense.
